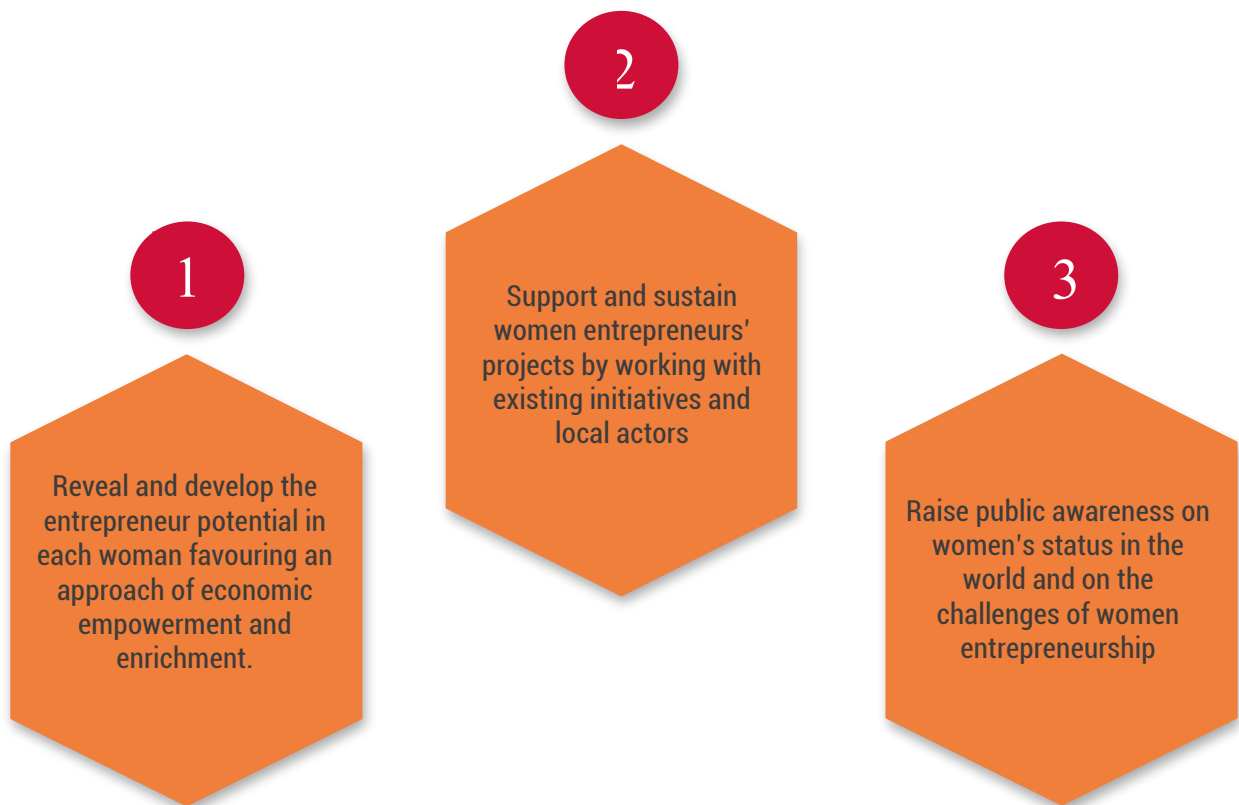


## VOLUNTEER POSITION IN MYANMAR

### ABOUT EMPOW'HER

Empow'Her is a non-profit organization, working for the social and economic empowerment of women worldwide since 2011. In a world where men and women are still not able to contribute equally to the development of their society, we rely on entrepreneurship to promote social equity and provide a platform for women to develop their own solutions. We are confident that entrepreneurship is a lever to support the full participation of women to the politic, social and economical development of their communities. Our actions aim to:

## OUR MODEL FOR ACTION

Our ambition is to **help women build their capacity** so they can find their own solutions to their project's challenges. To do so, and to ensure the sustainability of our actions:

- 🌐 We work directly with local partners and include them in our field programs to **build their skills and capacity**;
- 🌐 We implement impact measurement, which enables us to assess our programs and our impact both on women beneficiaries and local actors.

We are also convinced that France is filled with talented young people and students, who want to deal with other countries' realities by committing to a meaningful project. We hire and train groups of young people (students or not) with complementary profiles and send them on the field to partake in support and training missions for women.

## YOUR MISSION

As an Empow'Her Volunteer, your mission will be to support the YWCA (Young Women's Christian Association), the oldest organization in Myanmar helping vulnerable women. YWCA implements community programs aiming to support women's access to education and health and to promote their rights. Some of their activities also seek to support economic and social initiatives carried out by women through microcredit. YWCA is an apolitical and non-confessional organisation.

Your mission will be to support the YWCA team in setting up education and awareness workshops for women beneficiaries and follow their evolution, through the following tasks:



Providing support for collective training and following up with a group of women entrepreneurs in the textile industry;



Participating to workshops dedicated to optimizing women's local knowledge;



Providing support to the implementation of capacity building programs targeted at the 15 members of the YWCA;



Helping to evaluate the impact of Empow'Her's actions for women beneficiaries.

## CONDITIONS

The position is available from March for 7 months in Yangon, Myanmar.

The candidate must be eligible to a French "Service Civique" : European and <25 years old.
